

DANWA Health/Safety Precautions

As a business, we are taking the following steps to reduce the risk of spreading COVID-19 and other infectious diseases and increase the safety of our students and staff:

Instructors and/or Students are not to come to class, driving lessons, or our office if they:

- Have had fever (100.4° F), chills, difficulty breathing, aches, sore throat, nausea, or diarrhea within 24 hours
- Have not completed the Arkansas Department of Health's most recent recommended [quarantine guidelines](#) and [isolation guidelines](#) concerning COVID-19
- Have an unexplained, possibly contagious, cough or runny nose

We take these steps in our classroom:

- Use an air purifier (REME-HALO® BY RGF®) that is installed in our HVAC ventilation system
- Disinfect all contact points prior to students arriving
- Provide means for students to wash hands or clean hands with a wet wipe and/or hand sanitizer.

For our private, behind-the-wheel driving lessons, we take the following precautions:

- Disinfect the cars daily.
- Allow fresh air flow, when feasible.
- If any occupant in the vehicle at that time (student, instructor, or parent) requests it, then masks will be worn during in-car driving lessons by all occupants.
