“Weekday” Scholarship Offer

Driving Academy of Northwest Arkansas is offering scholarships up to a total of \$180 per person (\$10, \$15, or \$20 per lesson within the times and dates explained below) to every adult who meets all of the following criteria, for each lesson that meets the following criteria, on a first-come, first-serve basis for the lessons that are available:

- 1) Must register or already be registered at our website, www.DrivingNWA.com, for any Behind-the-Wheel Adult Driving Lessons.
- 2) Must be 21 years or older by April 8, 2019.
- 3) Must request this “Weekday Scholarship” by emailing Office@DrivingNWA.com and receive a confirmation email from us.
- 4) Must physically have a valid, current Arkansas driving permit or license at each driving lesson.

Lessons that qualify for the scholarship must meet all of the following criteria:

- 1) Must be taken on or after the date of the student’s confirmation of eligibility is sent from our office for this “Weekday Scholarship” through Friday, May 24, 2019.
- 2) Must occur **Mondays thru Fridays** and are scheduled to **begin** no sooner than 7:45 am and no later than 2:00 pm.

Each of the first four lessons that meet all of the above criteria will qualify the student for a \$10 scholarship per lesson. Each of the fifth thru eighth lessons that meet all of the above criteria will earn a \$15 scholarship per lesson. Any ninth thru twelfth lesson that meet all of the above criteria will earn a \$20 scholarship per lesson. The scholarship amount earned, up to a maximum of \$180, will be mailed to the student via a check no later than Friday, May 31, 2019.

All other policies of Driving Academy of Northwest Arkansas, as published in our current official bulletin available at our website, are still valid.

Lessons taken prior to the date the student’s eligibility was confirmed do not qualify for the scholarship or count in the accumulation of number of lessons.

Lessons given by our Driving Rehabilitation Specialist, Kimma Harper, do not qualify for the scholarship.
